REGULATIONS

- 1. There will be 2 separate calls in 2020. Deadlines as follows:
 - 1st June
 - 6th July
- 2. Calls are open to any composers who are 25 or under
- 3. Pieces should be unpublished and should have received no previous performances.
- 4. Submissions should be chamber pieces written in response to music by Beethoven in celebration of the 250th anniversary of his birth.
- 5. Duration should be 3 to 7 minutes
- 6. Instrumentation: small chamber ensemble (2 to 6 performers) details to be confirmed see below*
- 7. Source material: the Beethoven pieces that should be taken as the starting points will be chosen shortly, details to be confirmed see below*
- 8. Submissions should be accompanied by a short CV. These will not be opened until after the selection process has taken place.

*NB. Source material and instrumentation for each call will be confirmed approximately three months before its deadline. It will be announced via Twitter (@SoundWorld_UK), Facebook (@SoundWorldUK) and Instagram (soundworld_uk). Please follow us to keep up-to-date.

Details of the submission process will given at the same time.
