Composition Workshops Series *2020/21*

Do you write music?

Would you like the opportunity to work with leading performers and composers?

The annual Sound World composition workshop series is a unique opportunity for young composers (aged 15 to 18) from, or living in the south-west of England. The series begins with a half day introductory event in November. This features presentations on the different instrument families, with guidance on dos and don'ts, idiomatic writing, ensemble writing and score preparation.

This is followed by a full day workshop at which composers will have their music performed and recorded by professional musicians with guidance from a leading composer. There will be 5 workshops at venues across the region for students to choose from taking place between January and March.
